Drupal 9 is almost here

- Our current releases of GovCMS 9 is available on Github right now https://github.com/govCMS/GovCMS
- We're not yet production ready for SaaS but May 2021 is just around the corner

Our existing Drupal 8 SaaS customers

- GovCMS is running a process to automate the upgrade of your D8 SaaS website to D9 into a test environment
- Once this test environment has been created, customers/vendors will need to test and validate that their site functions, appears and works as expected
- If the site works as expected, customers/vendors confirming with GovCMS the D9 site can go live, replacing the live D8 site
- SaaS customers can book in their migration window with GovCMS now <u>https://www.govcms.gov.au/prepare-your-website-d9/book-your-d8-d9-migration-saas</u>

Our Drupal 8 PaaS customers

- Those in the PaaS space will need to upgrade their site, on or off platform
- Customers/vendors will need to test and validate that their site functions, appears and works as expected
- Customers/vendors are able to switch their site to D9 as it suits them

Our Drupal 7 SaaS and PaaS customers

- There's the opportunity to consider planning a move to either Drupal 8 or 9 now
- Take an audit of your site it's the best opportunity to consider site functionality, volume of content, currency of content, potential brand redesign, information architecture changes, any technical needs, timeframes and internal business requirements/deadlines
- If functionality or features do not exist or there are potential gaps when considering a move from Drupal 7 to 8/9 please let us know

Trying Drupal 9 with your site now

An opportunity to pre-empt issues

- Are there any issues with your theme?
 - Compatibility
 - General presentation
- Does all of your functionality still work?
- Has all your content loaded into the site?
- Is there anything unexpected?
- How much work is needed to resolve any of the above?

Installing Drupal 9

My setup

- Ubuntu 20.04 LTS
- Docker and supporting tools
- Most recent GovCMS 9 release from Github

In a nutshell

- Clone our D9 repository and get it up and running
- Take a very quick look at the site fresh
- Drop in some themes and see from the Appearance tab
- Import a database from an existing site and see what happens

Installing Drupal 9

Meanwhile, on another screen

Issues we've spotted

- Duplicated libraries.yml file
- need a code scan and fix few lines that are not using the D9 compatible functions in theme layer including the templates
- The base theme property in theme .info.yml files is now required
- themes/contrib/bootstrap contains an outdated version of <u>https://www.drupal.org/project/bootstrap</u>
- Requires forked copy of govcms8_uikit_starter placed into themes folder.
- filter method changing in Twig
- video_embed_field implementation
- Requires govcms8_uikit_starter fork
- Call to undefined method Drupal::entityManager()
- Should now be using mb_strtolower instead of Unicode::strtolower
