





Once you commit to a timeline, we **need** you to commit to it – there are some 150-ish sites and projects that need to be upgraded

## D7 timeline to end of life

---


- All D7 SaaS sites need to migrate to D9 no later than **November 2022**
- Aim to cut over no later than **September 2022**  
*(all good projects have contingency time built in)*



# D9 – if you're on PaaS

---

- Can create your D9 codebase off the GovCMS D9 distro – it's now available for download
- Don't need to use the distro – you can create your own
- Updates are easier over time if you inherit the changes Finance will do to the codebase



## Infrastructure changes

- Already underway –the first phase of this work is behind the scenes – agencies won't really notice anything
- Resilience and flexibility in how we use our infrastructure is a key priority – it's how we got through the crazy times last year during the pandemic



So what's  
changing?

- We're switching from **OpenShift** to **Amazon EKS**.

Both of these are versions of **Kubernetes**.

- JARGON ALERT! What is Kooo-baaah-need-eyes?
- It's an open-source system for automating deployments, scaling and managing applications.

# The great migration is coming!

- No not D9 – we need to migrate to new servers
- ALL 312 live sites – whether you're SaaS or PaaS
- We don't have all the details yet
- Its 3 times bigger than the last migration
