- RFP stage limited to those companies that take part in the EOI



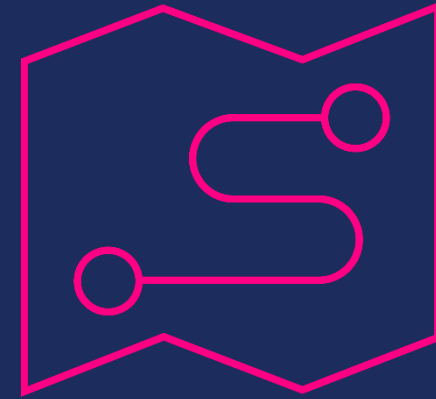

PHP 8.1 is recommended

## ❖ **PHP 8**

Security Support for PHP7.4 ends Nov 2022 [[Release 9.x-2.14.0](#)]  
Preview available 2nd week of April for 3 weeks

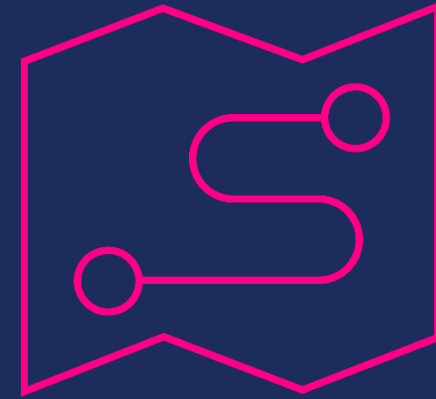
## ❖ **Drupal 9.4**

Expected to drop in June 2022

## ❖ **Drupal 10**

Planned for August 2022 but anytime to December

## ❖ GovCMS D10

Planned for December 2022
