What are views and how they are displayed?



- In GovCMS, a view is known as a listing of content on a website. The main purpose of views, is taking data (news, events, research, etc) from your website and displaying it to the intended audience.
- The view modules provide permission to site administrators and builders to create, manage and display lists of content (e.g. news page).

A listing created by a view can be in any of the following forms:

- Table with sortable fields
- Grid layouts
- Teasers or pictures that link to articles
- Blocks
- JSON output
- RSS feeds
- Calendars

How can display views be used?



There are several different displays that can present as pages with fixed URLs on your site and these are:

- Blocks
- Feeds
- Panel panes

The type of data that can be used to display views is almost any content that is stored in the system. For example, you can create the following lists for News and media:

Body: Text Field

Image: Image Field

Publication Date: Date Field Tags: Reference to taxonomy
