# Role Delegation

- Role Delegation allows Site Administrators to grant specific roles to users within a site
- While Site Administrators have been able to previously assign roles, it doesn't mean all roles have been visible or hasn't been convenient to action when managing a site
- Aligns to our Drupal 7 distribution with Role Delegation now in our 9 distribution
- Role Delegation gives more flexibility for managing users in a website, removing another bottleneck in process for those using GovCMS and our Service Desk

# Role Delegation

- Already have Module Permissions enabled? Then you (as a Site Administrator) can enable Role Delegation yourself

Install

- Module Permissions gives control over some modules and their configuration within a SaaS site, in a safe and secure manner

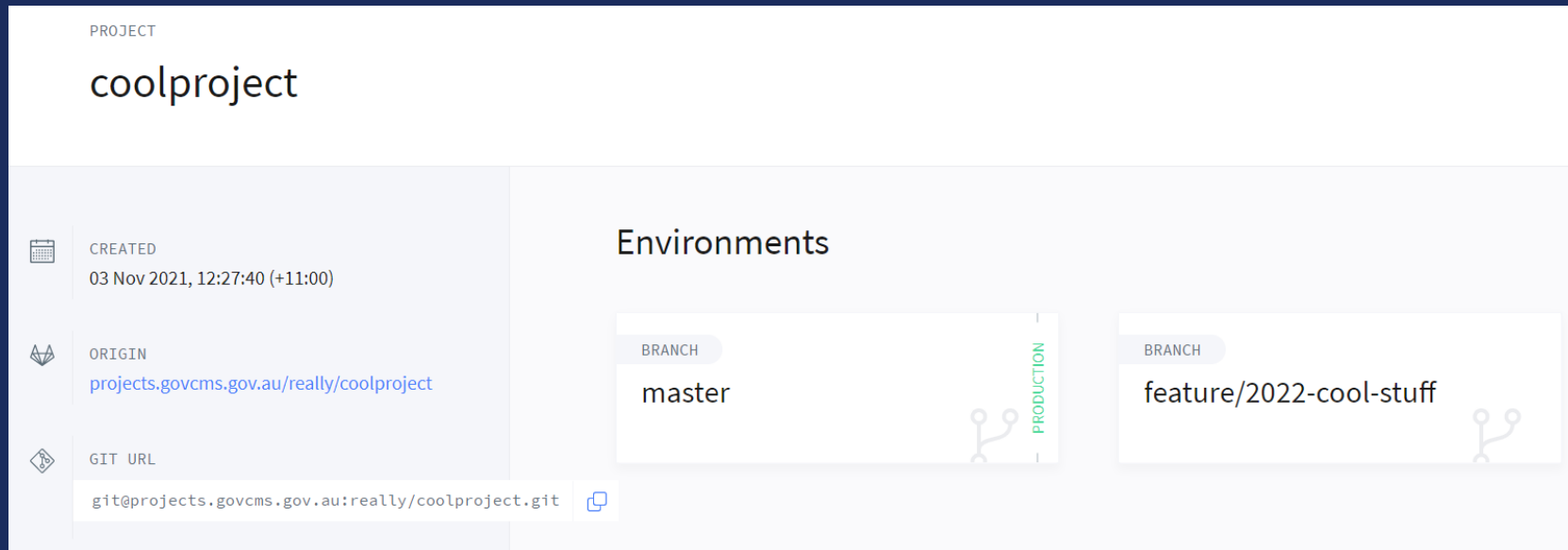
# Environments in the Dashboard

- Environments within GovCMS are used within a GovCMS project for a mix of reasons
  - Development cycle
  - “Pre-prod” for testing content and design solutions with internal customers
  - Staging for new features
  - Testing and designing functionality
- Each project allows for up to 5 environments, plus the Master environment which usually serves out the Live site
- Some GovCMS customers have opted for more environments as part of their hosting solution



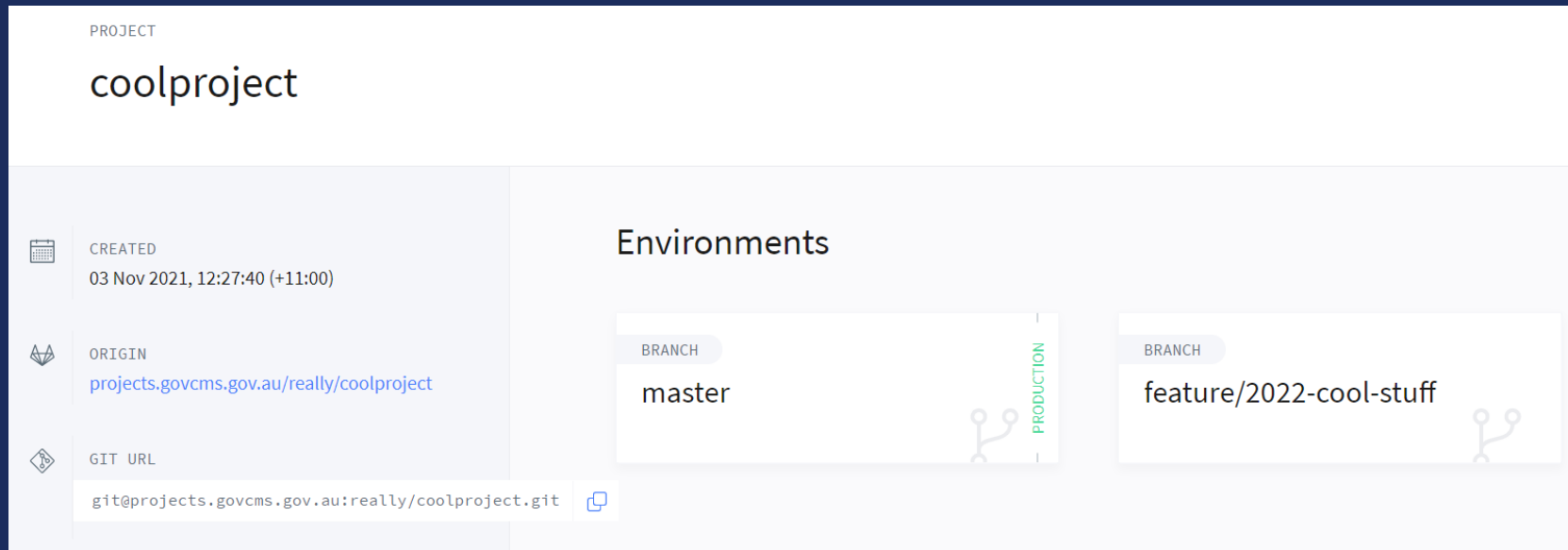
# Environments in the Dashboard

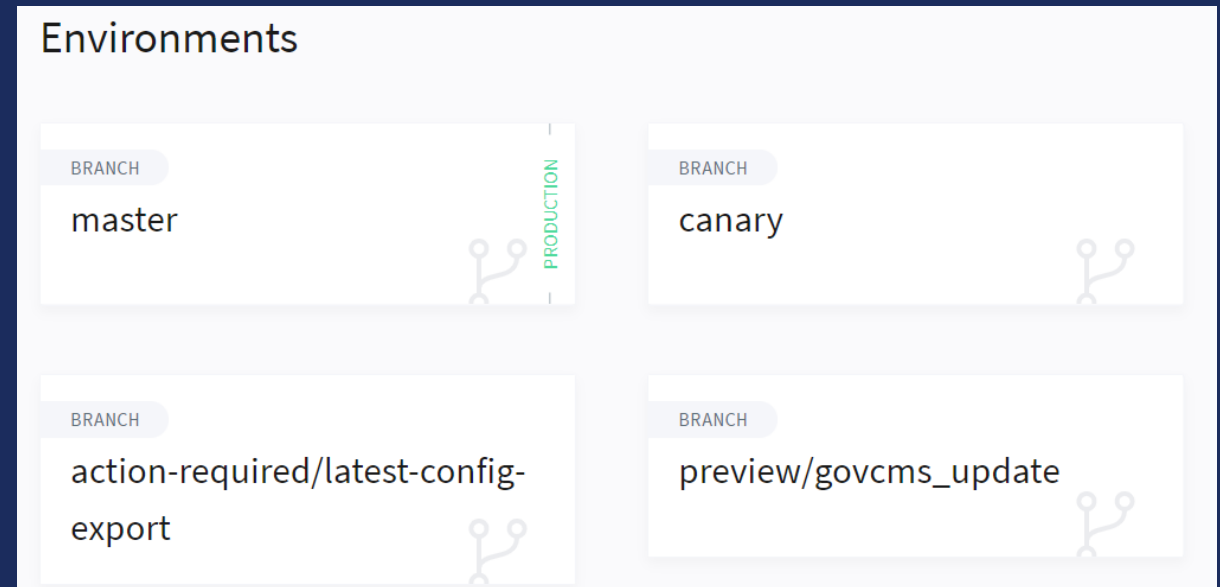

# Environments in the Dashboard

Similar to our Drupal 8 to 9 upgrade, we deploy additional environments to your project as needed for certain activities. We have rhyme and reason for all

- For major upgrades, such as our recent 9.3 release, we will create **preview/govcms\_update**
- Those with “canaries” will also have a **canary** listed
- Those with configuration import/export on, will also have a **latest-config-export** listed
- These don’t count towards your number of environments

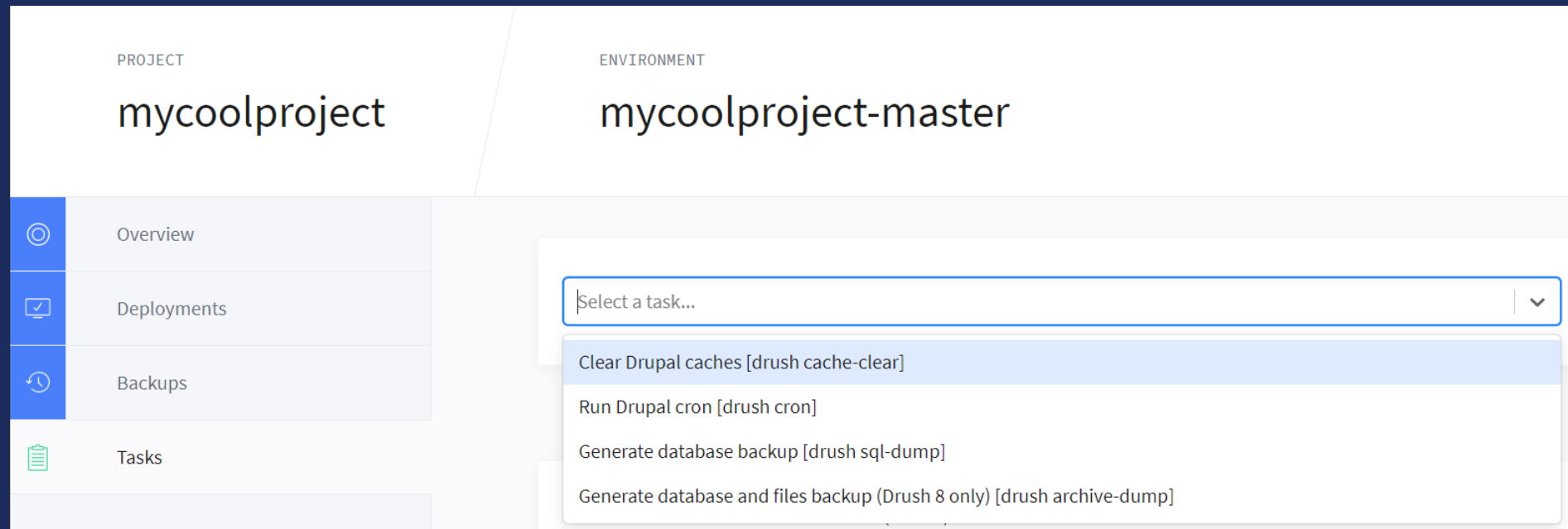


# Advanced Tasks in Dashboard
